# Effective Path to the Instrument Rating

This two hour presentation discusses the requirements for an instrument rating as spelled out in FAR 61.65 and FAA-S-ACS-8. The knowledge portion of the presentation is based on the sequence defined in ACS-8.

Regulatory requirements for maintaining currency as defined by FAR 61.57 will be augmented with discussions of methods to maintain proficiency. Logging of IFR flight time in accordance with FAR 61.51 will be presented as part of this discussion. Suggestions for preparing for the formal flight training are also synchronized with ACS-8. This portion of the seminar has the goal of enabling the prospective student to prepare for , and maximize the efficiency, of the formal training required to achieve the rating.

This no cost presentation is also the introductory session of the 36 hour Morey Airplane Co. Instrument Knowledge Course. Attendees will be given the opportunity to register for the course but are under no obligation to do so.
