Loss of Control due to pilots not staying proficient still ranks highest among the causal factors plaguing our pilots. Your local flight instructors will update you on pilot proficiency issues that they see during the flight reviews that could be avoided by regular training events.

We will also update on the New FAA Compliance Philosophy and how it impacts each and every pilot and mechanic.
