Following a short EAA Chapter 651 meeting, Lt Col Jerry Jessick, a Civil Air Patrol Mission Pilot, will discuss a recent engine malfunction that he experienced. During a New Years Eve flight the aircraft he was flying started vibrating, smoke entered the cockpit and oil spattered on the windscreen. Learn what caused Jerry to declare 'Mayday Mayday' and how he handled the situation. Jerry's presentation includes a narrated real-time track and vivid description of events. This real-world scenario will provide risk management insights and thought-provoking learning points about flying during our winter season.
