ACTIVE FLIGHT INSTRUCTORS are invited to participate in an exclusive CFI training program at EAA's Pilot Proficiency Center (PPC) on the EAA AirVenture grounds on Sunday July 21 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, the day before AirVenture opening day. The Pilot Proficiency Center's mission is to encourage ongoing skill improvement and to increase the proficiency of the overall pilot population. During AirVenture, PPC client pilots receive one-on-one training sessions from volunteer CFIs by flying the scenarios most appropriate to the individual using Redbird LDs. During the pre-AirVenture CFI Training Day, flight instructors receive an introduction to PPC operations, practice hands-on flying the scenarios and learn to operate the Redbird simulators and CloudAhoy debriefing tools. CFIs also have an opportunity for personal G1000 introductory training with experienced instructors.
