# IFR Approach Charts for the VFR Pilot

U.S. Terminal Procedures, (TERPS), can provide valuable Information to the VFR pilot as well as the instrument pilot. This information can aid in situational awareness, traffic avoidance, navigation and obstacle awareness as well as other information.

This seminar discusses what and where, information useful to VFR operations is contained in these publications. TERPS are available free to anyone willing to download them from the FAA or can be purchased from various commercial sources.
