Air frame ice forms most commonly between +2 to -20 degrees C. Ice accretion can cause roll and pitch upsets due to wing and tail stalls without warning. Immediate escape is essential. The pilot must stay calm, work the checklist, Aviate, Navigate and Communicate with ATC. The Sheboygan Falls (WI) EAA 766 IMC Club provides organized "hangar flying" focused on building proficiency in instrument flying. An instrument rating is not required for attendance.
