

VMC and IMC Scenario based Safety Discussion

VMC Question of the Month: Consider the yellow tinted areas on a sectional chart. If you are flying outside a yellow area, is that considered flying over a sparsely populated area with regards to minimum safe flight altitudes (FAR 91.119)?

IMC Question of the month: You're flying a light twin-engine airplane with an inoperative right engine, and are planning to land runway 22 with a right crosswind for landing. All other factors being equal, which direction would be preferred for the traffic pattern – left or right? Why?

We will discuss the answers to the two questions of the month as well as the **VMC** and **IMC** video scenarios and discuss what we would do if we wound ourselves in the same situations or more importantly, what we would do to prevent ourselves from getting in to those situations in the first place.
