This seminar is not meant as a lecture but rather an open discussion forum using real world scenarios to increase your level of safety in the IFR environment such as this scenario: **Chilling Choices.** On a winter flight in IFR conditions with ceilings of 1,000 to 1,500 feet overcast, visibility of 5 to 7 miles and temperatures below zero. As you approach your destination airport darkness has settled over the terrain and you notice your oil pressure has drop significantly.

To ensure a safe flight your priorities as PIC are to Aviate, Navigate & Communicate. Safe instrument flying is a matter of mitigating risk, personal minimums and standard operating procedures. The Sheboygan Falls (WI) EAA 766 IMC Club provides organized "hangar flying" focused on building proficiency in instrument flying. An instrument rating is not required for attendance.
