Only one supplier remains of tetra ethyl lead (the "LL" part of 100LL), and "Friends of the Earth" have initiated a lawsuit to ban 100LL in California due to the lead. In the mean time recent high 100LL prices have severely curtailed general aviation activity nationwide. So how about mogas, the other FAA approved piston aviation fuel? Is it safe? Is it okay for the airplane? Is it a way to fly more for less? We will explore these questions based on over 25 years of experience and research.
