Instrument Rating Ground School to help pilots pass the FAA Instrument Rating Knowledge Test as well as how-to presentations on approaches and holding patterns. This is a nine-week, one night per week course that covers all aspects of the Instrument Rating K.T. including rules/regs, weather, ADM, Airspace, ATC procedures, Instruments, Aerodynamics, and Approach/STAR/SID procedures. Wings Credit will be given for 8 of the 9 modules attended.

**Directions:** One mile south of Osceola on Highway 35. Turn East on 68th Avenue at Federated Coop. Take next left to terminal building. Southwest side of the airport.
