

North Star Flyers: Spatial Disorientation (Members Only)

Spatial disorientation remains a cause of fatal accidents despite rapid progress in the development of electronic flight displays. This seminar will address this topic. It will consist of two parts, a lecture covering spatial orientation and various illusions, and a demonstration of the concepts using a vertigo chair generously provided by the Fargo and Minneapolis FSDOs. Class size will be limited; please plan for approximately two hours to accommodate everyone in the chair. Light refreshments will be provided.
