Is your Airplane Airworthy? Learn how to quickly determine if any light airplane is legally airworthy, and what to do if it isn't. We'll cover certificates & documents, required inspections, airworthiness directives, and have a look at some logbook entries. Ferry permits and placarding items Inoperative will be discussed. Finally, the 4 most likely unairworthy conditions will be presented.
