

Powered Aircraft Cohabitating with Gliders

Learn about glider operations from pre-launch to thermalling and cross country flights to landing and how gliders and powered aircraft can safely occupy the airspace and runway environment together. Learn why gliders do what they do during launch and all phases of flight to better understand the risks.

You will also learn how easy it is to get a glider license, whether an initial license or an add-on to your current license.
