

## Winter Air Crew Operations Briefing

### Aircraft Icing

Ice build-up at the top of the hangar

Ice build-up outside the hangar on the hangar ramp

Ice on taxi-way or runway

Snow piles obscuring view or contacting wing tip

Frost bite during preflight inspection or refueling

Flooding the engine

Engine fire

Slipping and falling

**Directions:** The Civil Air Patrol hangar is at the north end of the Lake Elmo Airport (21D). Use Entrance A from Manning Ave., then go all the way to the north end of the airport.
