

Airman Certification Standards (ACS) Explained

The FAA and industry have partnered together to develop the replacement for the Practical Test Standards. The Airman Certification Standards bring substantial improvements to the certification process. This seminar will provide background on how the ACS was developed and explain how ACS will be used during both the knowledge tests and the practical tests.

There will be a brief safety presentation on how and when to conduct a post flight check after any maintenance is performed on an aircraft. Actual case history of incidents and accidents that have occurred during the first flight after maintenance.
