You'll be able to ask questions about how hand-offs work, why sometimes you need to change frequencies and sometimes you don't, understand how to best practice approaches, when to get VFR flight following or file, how to avoid getting a phone number, who is it you talk to when you call the number in the Chart Supplement to get a clearance, when can we shoot the RNAV 32 into KMIC and so much more. If time permits, we can head up to MSP Tower to see the view.
