

Minnesota Soaring Club Annual Safety Meeting

The annual Minnesota Soaring Club safety meeting prepares glider pilots for a safe soaring season. Issues to be discussed include changes to the landing pattern for gliders at Stanton Airport, how to use technology to assure a safe landing at KSYN, how to land at glider ports with no cross runway, a review of glider accidents in 2025, and a lecture by master rigger Mike Guillou on use of parachutes in emergencies.

From MN Highway 52 take the 80th Street East exit and travel one block west. It is on the south side of 80th Street East.

From South Robert Trail/Highway 3, take the 80th Street East Exit to the east, drive one mile. It is on the south side of 80th Street East.

From Highway 55 go north on 80th Street East, immediately turn on to 80th Street East going east (80th Street has only a turn to the east), drive one mile. It is on the south side of 80th Street East.
