

MSPA Safety Seminar - Playing Well in the Aviation Maintenance Sandbox

The owner of a General Aviation aircraft received all or most of their information about piloting a plane from their CFI but have received very little information about owning or maintaining an aircraft. If the owner hasn't spent much time with their local A&P or repair facility, there is usually a lack of knowledge.

This presentation is a starting point to help owners/operators/pilots understand their aircraft's maintenance needs and understand their relationship and maintenance facility.
