Holders of Inspection Authorizations

By attending this seminar and completing 8 hours of training either in one day, or both, or a combination thereof, will meet the requirement of 14 CFR 65.93(a)(4). It is the responsibility of the individual IA holder to ensure that renewal qualifications are met annually for the two year renewal cycle via any of the 5 methods outlined in 14 CFR 65.93(a)1-5. In addition, it is the individual IA holder who must retain records of such activity for each year of the two year renewal cycle. This year's seminar can be used for the year one period beginning April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2008. The next odd numbered year, 2009 is when your FAA Form 8310-5 will be renewed.


Directions to Rantoul National Aviation Center
