Holders of Inspection Authorizations

By attending this seminar and completing 8 hours of training either in one day, or both, or a combination thereof, will meet the requirement of 14 CFR 65.93(a)(4). It is the responsibility of the individual IA holder to ensure that renewal qualifications are met annually for the two year renewal cycle via any of the five methods outlined in 14 CFR 65.93(a)1-5. In addition, it is the individual IA holder who must retain records of such activity for each year of the two year renewal cycle.

Why Should I Attend?

- (IA's) Meets one of the methods for IA renewal IAW 14 CFR 65.93 (a).
- (Repair Stations) Meets the training requirements required by 14 CFR 145.163.
- (All Attendees) This seminar will provide you with a host of information critical to aviation safety and regulatory compliance.

Maintenance Technician Award Program

This training seminar makes you eligible to participate in the Aviation Maintenance Technician Award Program for 2010. Beginning this year, all applicants must register online at www.faasafety.gov to participate in the program. The program's purpose is to serve as an incentive for individual technicians and employers to actively participate in recurrent and initial training programs on their own initiative.

All training will now be recorded and tracked through the online program. Enroll, complete the requirements, and claim your AMT award certificate.
