#### Holders of Inspection Authorizations

By attending this seminar and completing 8 hours of training will meet the requirement of 14 CFR 65.93(a)(4). It is the responsibility of the individual IA holder to ensure that renewal qualifications are met annually for the two year renewal cycle via any of the five methods outlined in 14 CFR 65.93(a)1-5. In addition, it is the individual IA holder who must retain records of such activity for each year of the two year renewal cycle. Renewal is in odd number years.

### Why Should I Attend?

- (IA's) Meets one of the methods for IA renewal IAW 14 CFR 65.93 (a).
- (Repair Stations) Meets the training requirements required by 14 CFR 145.163.
- (All Attendees) This seminar will provide you with a host of information important to aviation safety and regulatory compliance.
