By attending this seminar and completing 8 hours of training you will meet the requirement of 14 CFR 65.93(a)(4). It is the responsibility of the individual IA holder to insure that renewal qualifications are met annually for the two year renewal cycle via any of the five methods outlined in 14 CFR 65.93(a)1-5. In addition, it is the individual IA holder who must retain records of such activity for each year of the two year renewal cycle. Renewal is in odd number years.
