Enhancing Your Situational Awareness as a Pilot

Situational awareness is a commonly used term among pilots and others in the aviation industry. The term "situational awareness" often refers to a pilot's awareness of the airplane's physical location in space, but extends outward to include all factors relating to the safety of the flight. A contributing factor in many accidents is a distraction that diverts the pilot's attention from monitoring the aircraft.

This presentation will focus on the key elements for discovering what situational awareness is, how pilots can develop or enhance situational awareness during flight operations, awareness of some hazards and traps which lead to a loss of situational awareness and will review some case studies involving situational awareness accidents.
