Presented by Steve Glenn, 'Worst Day of Your Life' covers the critical moments and days after an accident from the perspective of an aviation attorney, pilot, and investigator. He covers how to secure the crash scene, care for passengers, navigate NTSB Part 830 reporting requirements, and much more. Expect real accident photos and case studies throughout to bring the regulations to life. Attendees are eligible for Knowledge Topic 3 WINGS credit.
