A circling approach at an uncontrolled airport can quickly become one of instrument flying's most demanding situations. This interactive presentation will examine weather and visibility requirements, airport airspace, circling minimums, protected maneuvering areas, obstacle clearance, traffic-pattern entry, radio communications, wind, nighttime operations, and conflicts with other traffic. We will also discuss when to abandon the circle, how to execute the missed approach, and how ForeFlight tools can improve situational awareness. Bring your experience and judgment to this practical scenario-based discussion.
