A live, in-person FIRC is a professional conference in a very real sense since flight instructors are, by definition, professionals. The FIRC is not intended to rehash the basics, but rather to expose the instructor to the latest in flight training techniques, newest technology, and most importantly, operational and safety procedures.

Your temporary certificate will be issued upon successful completion of the FIRC. You may renew your flight instructor certificate up to 3 calendar months prior to your expiration month and retain the original expiration date.
