Don Weaver will be presenting "Fly the Aircraft First".

The FAA and industry are conducting a public education campaign emphasizing the necessity for pilots to maintain control of their aircraft at all times.

Background:

NTSB accident data suggest that pilots, while distracted by less essential tasking, have lost control of their aircraft and crashed. In light of this, pilots are reminded to maintain aircraft control at all times. This may mean delay in responding to ATC communications and passenger requests or not responding at all unless positive aircraft can be maintained throughout the flight. In other words, Fly the Aircraft First!

Talking Points: Discuss the role of distractions and inappropriate priorities in aircraft accidents. Offer tips to maintain proficiency and control discipline. Provide information on prioritization and dealing with distractions.
