Emphasis on the benefits of General Aviation Survival Training and Equipage.

The GAJSC has determined that a significant number of general aviation fatalities could be avoided if pilots were better prepared and equipped to survive forced landings and crashes. Survival training is strongly recommended as is carrying appropriate survival equipment on board the aircraft.

Teaching Points:

Discuss the scope and safety benefits of survival training and equipage. Acquaint pilots with available resources. Encourage pilots to train and plan for survival

Directions: Drive in - park at Main Terminal Parking Lot.
Fly-in - park at Main Terminal Ramp.
Main Terminal is located 1 building east of the Control Tower.
