

Understanding IFR Holding Patterns

Just like the perfect landing, the perfect holding pattern takes practice and understanding. This presentation will address common issues and areas of confusion related to IFR holding. Topics will include complex holding patterns, dealing with high winds, recovering from disorientation and use of satellite navigation systems.
