'Pilot/Controller Forum' and 'Sharing our Airspace'

The "Pilot/Controller Forum" will facilitate discussion between pilots and Air Traffic Control (ATC) to improve situational awareness of pilots and controllers about each other's jobs, workload, and problems.

"Sharing our Airspace" will facilitate discussion between pilots, FAA - Cleveland Flight Standards District Office (FSDO), FAA - Air Traffic Control (ATC), and the Ohio Air National Guard 179th Airlift Wing regarding runway safety and the sharing of airspace between General Aviation and the Military. The Ohio Air Guard will discuss topics relative to ground, low-level, tactical, and airdrop operations while identifying the flight safety risks associated with each. The Ohio Air Guard will identify various low-level and tactical routes of flight and area drop zones.
