The GAJSC is working to improve General Aviation safety through data driven risk reduction efforts that focus on training, education, and outreach.

The FAA and industry will conduct a public education campaign emphasizing the best practices regarding single-pilot CRM operational techniques. One aspect of CRM addresses management of unexpected events.
