

Loss of Control Presentation - Angle of Attack

Many loss of control accidents have occurred where airmen were unfamiliar with the visual or cockpit instrument cues for their aircraft in flight attitude such as level, climbs descent and turns.

This event will discuss the importance of having the aircraft trimmed to a level flight, hands off attitude, typical distractions that lead to loss of control, recovery from unusual flight attitude and human factors relating to disorientation.
