GAJSC Topic of the Month - 'General Aviation Survival'

In this presentation we'll address recommendations from the General Aviation Joint Steering Committee, a government/industry group that analyzes GA accidents and incidents. The Committee feels that improved survival planning before flight can significantly improve pilots' chances of surviving accidents and incidents and they recommend survival training. The General Aviation Joint Steering Committee (GAJSC) and your local FAA Safety Team (FAASafetyTeam) are working together to present a monthly topic that improves Aviation Safety. September's topic is "Pilots and Medications". The GAJSC is working to improve General Aviation safety through data driven risk reduction efforts that focus on training, education, and outreach.
