The Discover Aviation Center Flying Club encourages it's members to voluntarily report safety related events that they have encountered to identify hazards and develop controls that enhance pilot safety. Discover Aviation Center Flying Club members are required to participate in the FAA Wings Program to meet their requirements for their FAA flight review.
