Have you heard of your "Personal Minimums Checklist"? This checklist has been known as PAVE:

P - Pilot

A - Aircraft

V - Environment

E - External Pressures

Everyone must have a "Personal Minimums Checklist" to assure safe flight. Whether there are external or internal pressures, we all need to make a "go" or "no-go" decision to fly. The General Aviation Joint Steering Committee (GAJSC) determined that a significant number of accidents and incidents could have been avoided if the pilot used a "Personal Minimums Checklist". Come join us as we look at the human errors which continue to cause mistakes made by pilots.
