FAASteam Safety Seminar

The General Aviation Joint Steering Committee (GAJSC) reviews information relating to general aviation accidents. This information is then used as a "Topic of the Month" for presentations each month by the FAA Safety Team (FAASafetyTeam). We will review pilot liabilities and assets associated with the use of checklists. Winter aircraft operations involved risk based decisions associated with icing conditions. Often times the likelihood of an aircraft accident can be reduced by using a self-evaluating checklist. Personal minimums are set by the pilot-in-command and varies based on self-evaluation. Loss-of-Control seems to be an on-going concern for pilots, especially within five miles of airports. Instructor John Lillevold will discuss why pilots make poor decisions. This safety seminar will provide opportunity to share experiences and learn from our mistakes.
