This pilot briefing presentation will help pilots determine the airworthiness of an aircraft. Often times aircraft records are not reviewed before a flight to ensure the required maintenance is properly documented. Remember, it's the pilot who makes the final determination if an aircraft is in airworthy condition prior to flight. Register online to attend and receive WINGS credit.
