Inflight: Single pilot resource management, communication, planning ahead. Postflight: NASA report (should a safety issue arise). Sioux Falls (KFSD) Operations (Guest Speaker from the FSD ATC):

The three stages of situational awareness are: Information gathering. Understanding information. Anticipation.

Situational awareness can be defined simply as “knowing what is going on around us”, or more technically – as “the perception of the elements in the environment within a volume of time and space”. Situational Awareness influences our decision making and allows us to stay ahead of the aircraft. It helps us develop a mental picture of the world around us and use that mental picture to anticipate the future.
