

What's This Do?

The pilot - airplane interface is how the pilot communicates with the airplane and vice versa. Consideration of human factors in a well designed and managed cockpit can lighten the pilot's workload immensely!

Directions: I-5 SOUTH: EXIT 161, toward SWIFT AVE. RIGHT onto S ALBRO PL. RIGHT onto STANLEY AVE S. RIGHT onto 13TH AVE S. RIGHT onto AIRPORT WAY S. Follow AIRPORT WAY SOUTH for 1 mile. King County International Airport will be on the right. I-5 NORTH: EXIT 158 toward AIRPORT WAY/ E. MARGINAL WAY. Merge onto S BOEING ACCESS RD. Merge onto AIRPORT WAY heading NORTH for 2 miles. King County International Airport will be on the left.
