

So You're Flying to Canada; Now what?

Learn what the "essentials" are for flying to Canada & Alaska without violations. This presentation is given by an experienced pilot/CFI who has made over 120 Canadian crossings while leading groups of aircraft to Alaska.

Directions: Exit 101 from I-5. Go east past traffic circle to second light (Capitol BLVD), TR, go to 1st traffic light (Henderson BLVD), TR, make immediate left onto frontage road. Park outside gate 13 (man gate), code = 3512. If no parking is available go to gate 14, call 360-705-0585 for entry. If flying in, ask ground control for a progressive taxi to LetsFlyAlaska hangar and park on tarmac across from hangar or as directed by phone.
