

Is There a PAR Approach Available to General Aviation Pilots?

The Army ATC facilities at Gray AAF allow pilots to practice Precision Approach Radar (PAR) approaches. To safely use this benefit pilots need be familiar with Gray AAF, types of aircraft assigned, Army flight training and Special Use Airspace (R6703 and Rainier MOA).

Directions: From I-5, take the 128th St (exit #186). Go west on 128th St for approx 2 miles to Hwy 99, 128th St SW becomes Airport Rd. Stay on Airport Rd to the Paine Field entrance, turn left onto 100th St SW and go to the first stop sign, turn left and the street dead ends into our parking lot.
