Night Flight Operations (video and discussion) - 1 hour: We will view the video titled "Night Flying - Dusk to Dawn", developed by the FAA. The video will be followed by a presentation from Lt Col Jim Carpenter, Washington Wing Stan/Eval officer, addressing the risks and operational considerations unique to night flying. Pilots will then fly a night sortie of approximately 1.2 hours with a CFI, during which they will practice navigation, steep turns, slow flight, imminent stalls, and takeoff/landings.

Directions: From Hwy 512 go south on Hwy 161 (Meridain Avenue East) until you get to 168th Street East. Turn left into the airport. The CAP Building is just south of the restaurant and Spencer Aircraft.
