

'Wounded'

Captain Ed 'RIV' Hrivnak, Author of WOUNDED, A Legacy of Operation Iraqi Freedom, discusses the challenges of caring for our injured soldiers in-flight, and the heroic sacrifices by our servicemen using photos and video from actual combat missions. Hrivnak describes the differences of the C-141 and C-17 transports, pressurized and unpressurized flight operations, and details the 7 stressors of flight that affect all aircrew. "Riv" has been published in three books and is featured in a two time Emmy winning and Oscar nominated film. With over 4,000 hours on 20 different types of aircraft, Captain Hrivnak is one of the few people in aviation that has worked as an instructor flight nurse, airdrop loadmaster, helicopter CFI and search and rescue pilot.
