You have seen "pilot error" in the headlines so many times it makes you sick. The truth is, 80% of all accidents have some portion of the root cause in the decision making of the pilot. All pilots have made bad decisions. The lucky pilots live through the decision and learn from it. Unlucky pilots don't.
