Non-Towered Airports are Not Uncontrolled

Just because an airport does not have a control tower, does not mean it is without structure. Following the standardized FAA structure at nontowered airports minimizes your chance of traffic conflicts. If we all follow FAA guidance other aircraft will act predictably, minimizing traffic clashes.

Directions: Take the 128th Street exit (Exit 186), Turn left (west) on 128th, At the intersection of 128th St. & Hwy 99, 128th St. becomes Airport Road. Continue on Airport Road to 100th St. SW and take a left at 100th St. SW, Follow 100th Street West and travel through the 4-way stop.
