

# How to Safely Transition Your Aircraft from Parking to En-route through Class D Approach Airspace

With the arrival of the 2015 summer flying season, we have a desire to seek the freedom of the skies. So let's take a moment to discuss ground and flight hazards associated with aircraft movement and non-movement areas in Class D airspace and adjacent flight areas.

**Directions:** From I-5, take the 128th St (exit #186), go west on 128th St for approx. 2 miles to Hwy 99, 128th St SW becomes Airport Rd, stay on Airport Rd to Minuteman Rd, turn Left onto Minuteman Rd and go approximately 100 feet, turn right on E Perimeter Rd. Follow E Perimeter Rd to Regal/Crown Avionics on the eastside of Paine Field or continue on Airport Rd to the Paine Field entrance, turn Left onto 100th St SW and go to the first turn left and follow E Perimeter Rd to the parking lot next to Regal/Crown Avionics on the eastside of Paine Field.
