

## Preflight Inspection Complete

The accomplishment of a safe flight begins with a careful preflight visual inspection of the airplane. The purpose of this inspection is twofold: to determine that the airplane is legally airworthy, and that it is in condition for safe flight. We will discuss and perform a preflight visual inspection on an actual Cessna 172.

**Directions:** From I-5, take the 128th St (exit #186), go west on 128th St for approx. 2 miles to Hwy 99, 128th St SW becomes Airport Rd, stay on Airport Rd to Minuteman Rd, turn Left onto Minuteman Rd and go approximately 100 feet, turn right on E Perimeter Rd. Follow E Perimeter Rd to Regal/Crown Avionics on the eastside of Paine Field or continue on Airport Rd to the Paine Field entrance, turn Left onto 100th St SW and go to the first turn left and follow E Perimeter Rd to the parking lot next to Regal/Crown Avionics on the eastside of Paine Field
