

## Effective Spin Training for General Aviation Pilots

The debate about the value of spin training never ends, but too often the discussion doesn't include specifics about what that training should include. This presentation, which includes videos that show a variety of stall/spin scenarios, focuses on what pilots of typical GA aircraft should learn about stalls and spins, techniques to avoid common stall/spin situations, and if necessary, to stop the loss-of-control before it develops into a spin.
