

Combining On-Line Flight Planning with iPad Apps

iPad apps have changed the way we navigate during a flight but their small screens make them less than ideal for flight planning. Web-based flight planners on your PC or Mac are much better for pre-flight weather and flight planning but can't be used while flying. Learn how to combine iPad apps with a new generation of web-based flight planning tools.
