

Practical Importance of Weight and Balance - 2024 NW Aviation Conference

When learning to fly, we are taught how to work the charts and the math to figure the weight and balance, but there is far too little information in the primary sources as to why this is important. When we don't understand the 'why', we then tend to devalue the need for the process.
